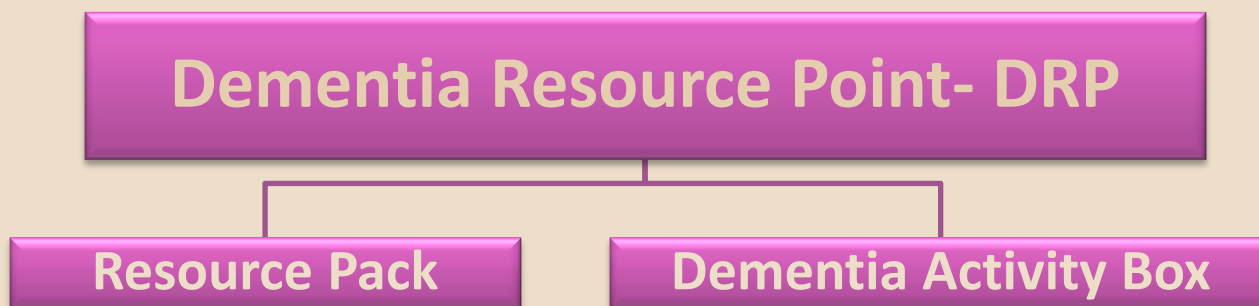


# Is Fós Mé Féin!

We also aim to provide a solution to facilitating meaningful engagement during hospital admission and beyond.



**Our Dementia Resource Point (DRP) will comprise of :**

- 1. Resource pack-** An easy-read resource pack with information regarding a dementia diagnosis, services available and it will include a hospital “Passport” for patients to carry across from their date of diagnosis with their list of medications and NOK details etc.
- 2. Dementia Activity Box-** Suited to individuals requiring stimulation with therapeutic intervention. It will include evidence-based items that will encourage conversation, interaction and are therapeutically beneficial for our patients wellbeing.
